Demonstrating an instructional strategy on YouTube

Select one of the strategies demonstrated by Kelly in her sheltered workshops or from Jeff's lecture on academic language (you can use more than one if you want to combine them) and use it/them to develop a lesson. Videotape yourself conducting the lesson with your class. Post the lesson to YouTube to share with the class. If necessary, please edit the video so that there will be no identifying shots of your students. Send the link (not the video file itself) to your Teaching Assistant. Note: If you prefer not to post to YouTube, you may complete this assignment by arranging with your Teaching Assistant to e-mail or turn in your assignment on a CD.

Do a brief write up where you:

1. Identify the strategy (or strategies) you chose.
2. Explain why you chose this strategy for this assignment.
3. Describe the class (or group) where you conducted this lesson (grade; subject; class or group size; number of ELLs in the class/group; English language proficiency levels of the ELLs).
4. Reflection on how the lesson went:
 - a. was the strategy successful? How do you know (or what makes you think so)?
 - b. why was it successful or not successful? Why do you think it "worked" or "didn't work"?
 - c. if you were to do the lesson over, what would you do differently? What would you not change?
